

English

In English, the children will be writing non-chronological reports in the style of Steve Backshall's 'Deadly 60'. This will require a secure understanding of writing for an audience and require the children to use different levels formality. The children will also be writing a 'Campfire Story' where they will cleverly retell a chilling horror story. The challenge will be that the story will be told through direct speech.

PE

In PE, the children will be learning to sustain their pace over longer distances and how to throw accurately.

Music

The children will be learning to sing as part of a chorus as they prepare for their end of year production of Oliver.

History/Geography

This term, the children will be studying Charles Darwin and his theory of evolution. They will explore the journey he took, which will involve the children producing some creative writing, the lands and species he explored and what this led him to believe. In addition to this, the children will conduct an experiment to demonstrate what Darwin discovered.

Computing

The children will be studying two units: Web Design and Machine Learning. They will learn how to create website and explore AI.
