

## English

- Our class reader will 'Long Walk To Freedom' by Nelson Mandela.
- We will be looking at the skills of paragraphing, punctuating speech, using fronted adverbials and adverbial phrases.
- The children will write biographies about a hero and narratives based on fairy tales.

## PE

## Maths

- We will finish our work on telling the time.
- The children will learn all about 2D and 3D shapes including what right angles are.
- Our last maths topics will focus on statistics; including bar charts, pictograms and collecting and interpreting data.
- We will also continue to learn the 2, 3, 4, 5, 8 and 10 times tables.

## History:

- In history we will be looking at heroes from the past such as Nelson Mandela, Rosa Parks, Emeline Pankhurst and one modern day hero—Marcus Rashford.
- We will research information about them and explain how these heroes have influenced life today.

## RE

- Our RE will focus on places of worship and how they are special.

## Art

- We will also make portraits of one of our heroes.

## PSHE

- Through discussion we will be learning about health and wellbeing. This will include: balanced diets, exercise and looking after our bodies.

## Science

- As part of our science learning, we will be studying forces, magnetism and how the Earth acts as a magnet.
- We will discover how forces work on objects and how they move on different surfaces.

## Computing

- We will use a programming tool, Kodu, to create a 3D land and control characters.
