Remote Learning

If your child is self-isolating, please find out how we are able to support you during this time until your child is able to return to school safely.

Home Packs: We will initially provide either a printed pack of work for up to 5 days or email the pack to your email if preferred.

Oak National Academy: We also ask that you use the [Oak National Academy](#). Here you will find daily lessons under the tab '[schedule](#)' as well as stand-alone lessons in [all subjects](#)

TEAMS Classroom: We are also in the process of setting children and staff up with TEAMS Classroom. Children will be receiving a login where they will also be able to access assignments set by the teacher. Your child will be taught how to use this and will have opportunities to practice in the coming weeks. This will also be used should we have partial or full isolation.

SWAYS: In the event of a full class bubble isolation or whole school isolation, we will point you to the direction of a weeks' worth of SWAYS, as in full lockdown, giving teachers time to get work ready for TEAMS classroom. SWAYS are documents created by teachers which are easy to access on any device.


Remote Live Teaching: In the event that your child's teacher has to self-isolate and is well enough to still teach, we are preparing and planning for them to be able to remote into the classroom and teach at least English and Maths.

Should the whole class bubble or the whole school have to isolate, we are also planning and preparing that your teacher will be able to either Remote Live Teach through Teams Classroom or record lessons for your child to watch on Teams Classroom. Again, we also ask that you use the [Oak National Academy](#). Here you will find daily lessons under the tab '[schedule](#)' as well as stand-alone lessons in [all subjects](#)

We, as a staff, are still learning so please be patient with us.

Hopefully we all remain safe and follow guidance carefully so that we will not need to have partial or full isolation as children will always learn best with face to face teaching, in class.
